Handbook for Relocating Federal Employees – U.S. General Services Administration Office of Governmentwide Policy

This guide assists federal employees in preparing for relocation. It identifies the benefits federal employees are entitled to and what options they have for relocation.

Federal employees are expected to be an active participant in all phases of their relocation. A successful relocation involves a partnership among the agency, contractors, and the employee being relocated. During a relocation, employees will have the opportunity to keep costs low and service high by involving themselves in the various aspects of a relocation.

This pdf includes general information for all relocators including:

- limitations on whether the Government will pay for relocation;
- information about specific relocation benefits and househunting trip (HHT);
- Temporary Quarters Subsistence Expenses (TQSE) ;
- Transportation and Temporary Storage of Household Goods (HHG);
- extended storage of HHG;
- residence transactions;
- use of a Relocation Services Company (RSC) etc.
